THE FOLLOWING IS A REQUEST FOR REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION

NEW ITEMS:

2021-09 Review request for the City of Santa Paula to look at the issue of parking in and around the Heritage Park Villas residential development on Dean Drive and March Street. On-street parking could be more efficient.

2021-10 Review request for the City of Santa Paula to look at adding 7 Handicap Parking spaces on both Railroad Avenue and 10th Streets to improve access to the churches within that one block radius.

OLD ITEMS:

2021-07 Review request for “No standing at any time” signs at various locations along Glade Drive, per S.P. Muni. Code §§ 72.01, 72.02, 72.03 (C) & (D) as there are currently many nuisances. Also, please replace the NO PARKING sign at the end of Glade Drive.

2021-08 Review request for speed humps near Bedall School on Hawthorn Street. Cars use this road as a speedway, and create a dangerous situation for the children both attending the school and who live on this street.

2021-06 Review request for the City of Santa Paula to paint the curb red in front of 352 Ojai Road where Saticoy meets Ojai Road due to speeding vehicles around Ojai Road. Resident is unable to see oncoming traffic from Saticoy when pulling out of driveway.

Action Taken: Bob will reach out to Karen at Caltrans with signage and frontage road.

2021-05 Review request for the City of Santa Paula to add a 15 Minute Parking area in front of 933 Yale Street due to vehicles parking for an unlimited amount of time in front of Alebrijes Juice Bar.

Action Taken: Clete recommended that Mike check the signage and make decision at the next meeting.

2021-03 Review request for the City of Santa Paula to install a Stop Sign on Santa Barbara Street at either 4th or 5th Street.

TSC Recommendations: Postpone conducting a Warrant Study until restrictions related to the Covid-19 Pandemic are discontinued, including the reopening of the all Santa Paula Schools. (this item will be combined with No. 2019-16)

2021-04 Review request for the City of Santa Paula to paint the Crosswalk and include Traffic Control at 1488 E. Harvard Blvd. to East Main Street.

Action Taken: Bob Woodward, Interim City Engineer would attempt to research this and report back to the TSC at a future meeting. (See Attached Email Correspondence and Photo)

The Traffic Safety Committee's recommendation was to not put in a sidewalk due to safety concerns. There is a need for brighter, visible stop signs. Mike will move to a sign closer to the recycling center that says "Welcome to Santa Maria.

2020-07 Review request for the City of Santa Paula to install Speed Bumps on the 1800 block of Cherry Hill Road and Stonegate Street due to an increasing number of vehicles speeding in the neighborhood.

Action Taken: City Staff will prepare a Draft Policy for Council consideration April 2021
